Situated on a quiet side street close to the bustling Termini area, the Hotel Milani is a European-style hotel. The Milani is just minutes from the Basilica of St Mary Majors, the Piazza de Repubblica and the Via Nazionale. The Milani hotel offers 74 rooms, all with en suite facilities, AC, telephone, TV and hairdryer. There is also a small bar and lounge area.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Departure from Boston

Depart from Boston on your non-stop Alitalia flight to Rome.

Day 2: Transfer to the Hotel Milani

Upon arrival in Rome retrieve your luggage and clear customs. You'll be met by our local representative who will assist you during the transfer to the **Hotel Milani** in downtown Rome. Check in and receive room assignments. The rest of the day is at leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and surroundings.

Day 3: Rome

After enjoying a full American breakfast, depart the hotel with your local tour guide for a half day guided tour dedicated to the discovery of the most beautiful Squares and Fountains of Rome. Piazza della Repubblica with the Fountain of the Najads with the background of the Church of St Mary of the Angels created by Michelangelo. Continue to Piazza del Quirinale, with the beautiful fountain and its obelisk. You will stop at at the Trevi Fountain and then walk over to Piazza di Spagna (Spanish Steps) with the Barcaccia Fountain, Piazza Monte Citorio, Piazza del Pantheon and finally Piazza Navona, with the fountain of the Four Rivers. Return to the hotel the remainder of the day and evening is at leisure. **(B)**

Days 4, 5, 6: Rome

Enjoy breakfast each morning and the days are free to discover Rome just the way you like it. **(B)**

Day 7: Return flight to Boston

This morning you will be transferred by private motorcoach to the Rome Airport for your return Alitalia flight to Boston arriving in the afternoon. **(B)**
