Next, you'll revel in the beauty of Siena and the fine wine of Montecarlo. Near the end of the week you'll explore the **Cinque Terre**, five small villages accessible only by foot or by boat. This fabulous trip is led by expert guides, so instead of struggling with guidebooks, you'll be clued in to all the "can't miss" spots along the way. DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Overnight Flight

Depart from Boston this evening on Alitalia Airlines. Dinner is served aloft along while crossing the Atlantic. Relax and enjoy in-flight entertainment.

Day 2: Arrive Rome – connecting flight to Florence – transfer to Montecatini

Continental breakfast will be served on board before landing. You will clear immigration and proceed to your domestic flight for Florence. Upon arrival, you clear customs and meet your professional Tour Manager who will escort you to the **Hotel Plaza in Montecatini Terme**. www.hotelpiazza.it

After check-in and room assignments you'll enjoy lunch and have the balance of the afternoon to relax and get settled. In the evening you'll get acquainted over dinner at the hotel. **(L, D)**

Day 3: Siena & San Gimignano

After breakfast you'll depart by motorcoach for Siena, a medieval town with "the most beautiful piazza in Italy" designed in the shape of a scallop shell. You'll enjoy a half-day guided visit before you continue on to San Gimignano, a splendid medieval small town situated between Florence and Siena, known throughout the world for its forest of towers emerging from the ancient houses. It is a city of towers, but also one with a long history starting from the significant Etruscan remains that placed San Gimignano among the cities on UNESCO's World Heritage List. Return to Montecatini for dinner and overnight **(B,D)**

Day 4: Florence

Today you'll set off for a full-day visit of Florence. Upon arrival you'll enjoy a half-day guided walking tour featuring the Duomo, the Baptistery with the Gate of Paradise, Piazza della Signoria and Palazzo Vecchio. The afternoon is free to explore on your own or shop for Florentine leather and gold. You'll return to Montecatini in the late afternoon. Return to the hotel. Dinner on your own and the evening is at leisure. **(B)**

Day 5: Lucca

Today's full day excursion is a lovely treat. First you'll visit Lucca, the only medieval town in Italy still surrounded by its original 14th century walls. Lucca is a town filled with ancient Roman ruins, as well as great furniture, jewelry and antique shops. Enjoy a guided walking tour including admission to Palazzo Manzi. Continue on to Montecarlo in the beautiful Tuscan countryside to the "Fattoria Il Poggio" for a wine tasting and lunch -- a real "Paesana Feast." In the late afternoon return to hotel for dinner and overnight. **(B, L, D)**

Day 6: Montecatini

After breakfast you'll visit Montecatini Alto -- the original Montecatini settlement, lying a few hundred meters above the "new town." The views from here are splendid and the delightful Piazza Giusti is home to some good bars and restaurants. Return to Montecatini for free time to visit the open-air market and mingle with the locals. In the afternoon a cooking demonstration will be held at the hotel. **(B, D)**

Day 7: Cinque Terre

Get ready for a highlight of your vacation. After breakfast you'll depart for the Cinque Terre to enjoy a full-day guided visit. The Cinque Terre, also known as the Gulf of Poets, was the later home of Lord Byron, Percy B. Shelley and many others. The landscape and quaint villages exude an inspirational charm that undoubtedly drew these writers to the region. Charles Dickens, in *Pictures from Italy*, wrote: "There is nothing in Italy, more beautiful to me, than the coast road between Genoa and La Spezia: a landscape consisting of sea and land, terraced vineyards and olive oil, the enchanting flora of the Mediterranean scrub and sweet fragrances." You also enjoy lunch and wine tasting at a typical local restaurant. In the late afternoon you'll return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. **(B, L, D)**

Day 8: Day of Leisure in Montecatini

Breakfast and dinner are provided today and the rest of the day is yours to spend as you wish. **(B, D)**

Day 9: Return to Boston

Early morning transfer to Florence airport for your return flight to Boston via Rome. **(B)**
