Board your luxury executive coach in Boston at South Station at 8:30am or 9:00am at Riverside MBTA Station, Newton. (Location: EXIT 22, Route 128 South) and depart for New York City. Arrive New York City approximately 2:00pm and check into the **Intercontinental New York Barclay**. The drive is approximately 5 hours. Please bring lunch and snacks for the ride. The
