Next, get ready to swoon during an evening of music and dance provided by the famous Tommy Dorsey Orchestra followed by "**The Sinatra Legacy**" during an enchanting evening of seaside dining. The highlight of this getaway, however, may just be a memorable **USO tribute show** to the comedy of **Bob Hope**, the harmony of the Andrews Sisters and the music of **The Glenn Miller AAF Band.**

#### **DAILY ITINERARY**

##### **Day 1: Departure from the Boston Area - Arrive Fredericksburg**

Today we journey to historic Fredericksburg where accommodations are provided at the Best Western.

##### **Day 2: Virginia Beach**

This morning we finish our journey to the largest pleasure beach in the world...beautiful Virginia Beach. You'll enjoy oceanfront accommodations for the next three nights. You'll be able to stroll on the scenic boardwalk and witness the beach's beautifully landscaped parks. This afternoon a guided tour will serve as an introduction to this incredible area. A spectacular evening awaits us as we enjoy a candlelit seafood dinner in the famed oceanfront ballroom of the Cavalier Hotel. As dinner concludes the Tommy Dorsey Orchestra takes the stage to warm up the audiences for our headline act - the Sinatra Legacy - a special tribute to the music of Frank Sinatra. Dance the night away to such classic hits as "Come Fly with Me," "The Lady is a Tramp," and "Mack the Knife." What a fabulous evening! (**B, D**)

##### **Day 3: Norfolk**

Today travel to Norfolk to discover the MacArthur Memorial. At this National Historic Site we'll view a film about the times of General Douglas MacArthur. We continue our patriotic theme as we tour the United States Naval Base. Our enlisted sailor guide will lead a compelling tour of this magnificent

complex. Later return to your hotel where you'll have time to enjoy the boardwalk and the fabulous beach area. Explore shops and restaurants or even rent a bike! This evening enjoy an impressive buffet dinner followed by an evening of music - "Tribute to the Jersey Boys: The story of Frankie Valli and the Four Seasons". This outstanding live show will have you dancing in the aisles, featuring such hits as "Oh What a Night," "Working My Way Back to You Babe," and many more! **(CB,D)**

#### **Day 4: Military Aviation Museum -USO Show**

This morning we're off to the Military Aviation Museum, home of one of the largest private collections of WWI and WWII military aircraft. Here enjoy a fabulous air show featuring narration of the planes with music of the era. Later enjoy a southern style cookout in the Hangar. At the Sandler Performance Hall, you'll enjoy a memorable USO show tribute featuring the comedy of Bob Hope, the harmony of the Andrews Sisters and a 14-piece orchestra that pays tribute to the greatest military band of all time, The Glenn Miller AAF Band. The song list includes "Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy," "In the Mood," "Moonlight Serenade" and many more. Tonight, we return to the Cavalier Hotel for a 1960's outdoor beach party, themed with the music and movies of Elvis, the Beach Boys, and Frankie and Annette. Take in the oceanfront view as you enjoy live music, hors d'oeuvres and a dance floor on the patio of the hotel. **(B, L)**
