The heart of Venice, **Piazza San Marco**, looks as perfect as a film set, and the panorama across the water is precisely as Canaletto painted. **The Grand Canal** is the most beautiful street in Venice, surrounded by opulent architecture and bustling with watercraft! There's more to Venice than her past glories— follow her narrow streets to tiny piazzas, stroll the quayside promenade lined with restaurants and cafés, then stop at **Gelateria Nico**, the perfect spot to indulge the twin Venetian passions: watching boats and eating gelato!

This family-run hotel features two elegant restaurants, each with its own cuisine and style.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Departure from Boston

Depart from Boston on your Air France non-stop flight to Paris.

Day 2: Arrive Rome

Continental breakfast will be served on board before landing. You will clear immigration and proceed to your connecting flight to Venice. Upon arrival in Venice, retrieve your luggage and clear customs. You'll be met by our local representative, who will assist you with the motorboat transfer to the Hotel All Angelo, your home for the next five nights. Check in and receive room assignments. The rest of the day is at leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and surroundings.

Day 3: Venice

After breakfast at the hotel you will meet your local guide for a walking tour of Venice You will visit the Piazza San Marco, the lively heart of the “Serenissima,” which is surrounded on three sides by historical buildings with arcaded facades. You will also see the Clock Tower, Doge’s Palace and the Bridge of Sighs The afternoon and evening are free to discover Venice on your own. Stroll to the Rialto Bridge market to shop for bargains and souvenirs. For sheer romance, try a Gondola ride on the Grand Canal. **(B)**

Days 4-5-6: Venice at leisure

Enjoy breakfast each morning and the days are free to discover Venice just as you like it at your own pace. **(B)**

Day 7: Return flight to Boston

Transfer by motorboat to the Venice Airport with assistance for your return flight back to Boston via Paris. **(B)**
