DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Overnight Flight

Evening departure from Boston to Rome, via Alitalia Airlines. Dinner will be served on board Relax and enjoy the in-flight entertainment.

Day 2: Arrive Rome – transfer to Naples

Continental breakfast will be served before landing in Rome. Clear immigration and proceed to your connecting/domestic flight to Naples. Retrieve your luggage and clear customs and meet our local representative who will assist you with the transfer to the Hotel San Francesco in Maiori. Check in and receive room assignments. The rest of the day is at leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and surroundings. Lunch and dinner will be served at the hotel. **(L, D)**

Day 3: Cooking demonstration – Pompeii excursion

After breakfast, you are invited to a cooking demonstration at the hotel; a great opportunity to learn some secrets of Mediterranean cuisine. After lunch at the hotel you depart for an excursion to Pompeii. A local professional guide will lead you on a walking tour of the ruins of this Roman town buried by a sudden eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79AD. Thanks to the patient work of talented archaeologists, Pompeii comes to life once again. Walking through the ancient streets of Pompeii you'll enter ancient dwellings with exciting frescoes, pause at the baths and browse through the shops that were open 2000 years. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B, L, D)**

Day 4: Capri

Perhaps the highlight of this holiday--today you'll enjoy a full-day guided excursion to the magical isle of Capri. Transfer by motor coach to the port of Amalfi and proceed by ferry across the Gulf of Salerno to Capri. Your local guide will lead you on a tour of the island by minibus, a visit of Villa San Michele, the famous "Piazzetta" and the Gardens of Augustus that overlook the famous Fraglioni rocks. There will be free time to browse around and shop before lunch at a local restaurant. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B, L, D)**

Day 5: Maiori – ceramic lesson

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. The morning is free to enjoy "La Dolce Vita on the Amalfi Coast". After lunch at the hotel you'll visit a local artisan shop and enjoy a ceramics lesson. Learn the secrets of this tradition from a master and watch him at work creating a masterpiece. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B, L, D)**

Day 6: Maiori – Day of Leisure

Today is your day to explore the Amalfi Coast on your own. All meals today are provided by the hotel. **(B, L, D)**

Day 7: Sorrento – Amalfi – Positano

After buffet breakfast at the hotel you'll depart on a full-day excursion. Your first stop will be the quaint town of Sorrento. Enjoy a walk through Piazza Tasso and the narrow streets nearby. You'll be treated to lunch at a local restaurant and later head to the town of Amalfi and then on to famous Positano. This is the most elegant and well-known resort town of the Amalfi Coast with ancient origins – it was founded by the fugitives of Paestum who had escaped from the Saracens. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. **(B, L, D)**

Day 8: Maiori

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Your last full day is totally free to enjoy the peaceful life on the Amalfi Coast, a land blessed by the warm Mediterranean sun. Dinner will be served at the hotel followed by an evening of music and dance. **(B, D)**

Day 9: Return to Boston

Early morning coach and a to-go breakfast as you are transferred to Naples airport for your return flight to Boston, via Rome. **(B)**
