King Tut Exhibit

For the first time in a generation the collection of artifacts from King Tut’s tomb visits NYC. *Tutankhamun and the Golden Age of the Pharaohs* explores the figures that guided ancient Egypt more than 3,000 years ago. The exhibition focuses on the 18th Dynasty, a 100-year period when Egypt was at the height of its power and the “golden age” of Egyptian artistry. The extensive array of more than 130 extraordinary artifacts features 50 of Tutankhamun’s burial objects.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Friday

Board the Limo Liner in Boston at South Station at 8:30am or 9:00am at Riverside MBTA Station, Newton. (Location: EXIT 22, Route 128 South) and depart for New York City. Arrive New York City approximately 2:00pm and check into the Jolly Hotel Madison Towers. The drive is approximately 5 hours. Please bring lunch and snacks for the ride. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure. This evening make your way to the Imperial Theatre to enjoy an 8pm performance of *Billy Elliot*.
