Capriccio Festival

Ogunquit, Maine

Saturday, September 19 - Monday, September 21, 2009

In September, **Capriccio** returns to Ogunquit with its 19th annual two-week long Celebration of the Arts, a town-wide festival unrivaled in New England. Art, music, poetry, ballet, live theater and design are displayed and performed at various venues, most within walking distance of the village. Ogunquit's attraction is a one-two punch of world-class beaches followed by the art and culture reflected in its array of galleries, museums and theater. "Beautiful place by the sea" has long been one of Maine's premier resort villages and artists' colonies. Spend two scenic hours aboard the **Downeaster** from North Station to Wells arriving before noon with plenty of time to head for the village, the art museum, Perkins Cove or even the beach. On Saturday evening you'll enjoy a performance at the **Ogunquit Playhouse**, the epitome of summer stock theater. Sunday is a free day to enjoy the festival events, including the popular antiques show held at the **Dunaway Center** in the village. (The 2009 schedule of activities and performances will be available in mid-August.)

DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Depart Boston

Depart from North Station approximately 8:50am* via AMTRAK (coach class service) to Wells, ME, arriving at approximately 10:35 am. Walking and trolley maps along with an Ogunquit Visitors Guide will be provided by your "Lobster Lady" who will greet you upon arrival and transfer you by trolley to the **Ogunquit River Plantation** for a welcome reception and check-in. Upon arrival you will receive your welcome packet with 6 trolley tokens for use

on the Ogunquit Trolley, two breakfast coupons for a deluxe continental breakfast at the hotel and a coupon for admission to the Ogunquit Museum of Art and the show ticket. Your afternoon is free to explore on your own. This evening you will be transferred (roundtrip) to the historic Ogunquit Playhouse. This cultural landmark has, for five decades, brought outstanding star-studded performances to Maine. Your show tonight will be the Elvis inspired ***All Shook Up***.

Day 2: At leisure

A deluxe continental breakfast is provided at the hotel this morning. Afterwards, the day is yours to enjoy the Annual Cappriccio Festival of Arts at your leisure. Don't forget to use the coupon for admission to the art museum and also plan to stroll through the antique show at the Dunaway Center located in the center of Ogunquit Village. **(B)**

Day 3: Depart Ogunquit

Enjoy your included breakfast at leisure this morning. In the early afternoon a chartered trolley will come to the hotel and transport you back to the Wells station for your return train ride to Boston. **(B)**
