## DAILY ITINERARY

### Day 1: Drive to Ogunquit

Make your way to Ogunquit, Maine-which means "beautiful place by the sea"- for your weekend getaway. Meet "The Maine Lobster Lady" at check in at the Ogunquit River Inn where you'll stay

for two nights. The Ogunquit River Inn overlooks Rachel Carson Refuge, the marsh and river with distant ocean views. Take a swim in the outdoor heated pool or Jacuzzi, watch the seabirds on the marsh, enjoy the fresh salt air and hear the waterfall next to the hotel. This evening you'll attend the musical **Chicago** at the Ogunquit Playhouse. This cultural landmark has brought outstanding star-studded performances to southern Maine for five decades.

### **Day 2: Day at Leisure in Ogunquit**

After an enjoyable breakfast, you may spend some time exploring the area. You may drive or use the included trolley tokens to Ogunquit's three most visited locations - Ogunquit Beach, Ogunquit Village or Perkins Cove. There are shops, galleries and antiques stores to browse, plus a winding walking path between Perkins Cove and the Village called "The Marginal Way" a scenic place to stretch your legs or relax on a bench to watch the crashing surf. Ogunquit was one of America's first art colonies and included is admission on Saturday to the Ogunquit Museum of American Art. The museum features 20<sup>th</sup> century American Art and is located in a spectacular waterfront setting near Perkins Cove. (CB)

### **Day 3: Morning at Leisure/Check out of Inn**

Once again enjoy breakfast and have the morning at leisure before checking out of the Inn. As you have your own vehicle there's no need to rush home – you can enjoy the day in beautiful Ogunquit. (CB)
