This is the trip that made the club famous! Whether it's your first trip to Paris or your twenty-first, this Travel Club classic remains one of the best values in travel today! For this getaway we've chosen accommodations in the storied and historic Latin Quarter—the heart of the Left Bank. Known for its lively atmosphere, cafes and bistros, the Latin Quarter has been the intellectual center of Paris since 1253. Bookstores, schools, churches, jazz clubs, Roman ruins, publishing houses and boutiques characterize this district and it is home to the Sorbonne. The traditional center of what was called "bohemian Paris," the Quarter is also the setting for Puccini's opera, La Bohème. Place St-Michel—with its pink marble fountain—is the busiest spot in the Latin Quarter and is surrounded by cafes facing the Seine and Notre Dame. You'll stay at either the Sully St Germain or the Moderne St Germain, two adjoining hotels on the rue des Ecoles—close to the Pantheon, Place de Catalogne, the banks of the Seine and its used booksellers, and Notre Dame. You'll be just a ten minute walk from the Musée d'Orsay, the Louvre and Montparnasse. Be sure you make time for the Musée de Cluny (or National Museum of the Middle Ages) with its magnificent collection of medieval art and the Jardin des Plantes, a centuries old botanic garden.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Overnight Flight

Late- afternoon, non-stop Air France flight from Boston to Paris. Dinner will be served on board. Relax and enjoy the in-flight entertainment.

Day 2: Arrive Paris

Continental breakfast will be served before landing in Paris. Retrieve your luggage and clear customs. You will be met by our local representative who will assist you during the transfer to the Hotel Sully St Germaine or Hotel Moderne St. Germaine, your home in Paris for the next five nights. Check in and receive room assignments. The rest of the day is at leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and surroundings.

Days 3 – 6: Paris

Enjoy buffet breakfast daily and the rest of the week is yours to spend exploring this marvelous city. **(B)**

Day 7: Return to Boston

Depart your hotel in the morning for your private motor coach transfer to the Air France terminal at Charles DeGaulle Airport. Depart Paris on non-stop service to Boston arriving in the afternoon. There will be meal service en route. **(B)**
