Situated on a quiet side street close to the bustling Termini area, the hotel Milani is a European-style hotel. The Milani is just minutes from the Basilica of St Mary Majors, the Piazza de Repubblica and the Via Nazionale. The Milani hotel offers 74 rooms, all with en suite facilities, AC, telephone, TV and hairdryer. There is also a small bar and lounge area.

DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1: Departure from Boston

Depart from Boston on your Alitalia non-stop flight to Rome.

Day 2: Arrive Rome

Upon arrival at the Rome airport you'll transfer, by private motor coach, to the Hotel Milani. The rest of the day is at leisure.

Days 3: Rome

After breakfast at the hotel you will enjoy a motorcoach panoramic city tour of Rome. View Piazza della Repubblica, the Baths of Emperor Diocletian and the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels, designed by Michelangelo. Continue to Piazza Venezia with the Victor Emanuel Memorial to the unknown soldier, the Capitol, Trajan Market, the Roman and Imperial Forums, the Colosseum, the Arch of Constantine, Circus Maximus, Palatine Hill and the Theatre of Marcellus, the Jewish Ghetto. We cross the Tiber and to see Castel Sant'Angelo, and finally you will view St. Peter's Basilica. The remainder of the day is at leisure. **(B)**

Days 4-5-6: Rome at leisure

Enjoy breakfast each morning and the days are free to discover Rome just the way you like it. **(B)**

Day 7: Return flight to Boston

Transfer to Rome airport with assistance for your return flight back to Boston. **(B)**
