## **Ogunquit Theater Getaways**

**JUST 90 MINUTES FROM BOSTON** you'll find "the best vacation to be had in the Vacation State" in Ogunquit, Maine. From its world-class scenery to its joyful art scene reflected in its array of galleries, museums and theater, Ogunquit is New England at its best. Each of these getaways includes two nights at the Meadowmere Resort and a performance at the famed Ogunquit Playhouse, a Nubble Lighthouse narrated cruise and admission to Ogunquit Museum of American Art.

### Wednesday, July 17

Make your way to Maine's pristine south coast region for a mid-week theater getaway! We'll provide directions for the most direct route – and "the scenic route". Meet "The Maine Lobster Lady" at a welcome reception at the Meadowmere Resort. Stay two nights at this lovely resort, just a ten-minute walk from the Ogunquit Village shops, Perkins Cove and the Marginal Way shoreline walking path which connects Ogunquit Beach with the Village and Perkins Cove. The village and Perkins Cove offer many boutiques, shops, art galleries and restaurants. Take a dip in the indoor or outdoor pools, order a spa service or relax in the Jacuzzi. Theater and activity tickets, local maps and a Maine souvenir will be provided at the 4-5 pm welcome reception or left for you at the front desk if arriving later. Dinner on your own tonight (or included at Jonathan's) with a variety of restaurant options nearby and menus available to peruse at welcome reception. (Some rooms are on upper floors, please let us know if you have walking difficulties.)



### Thursday, July 18

**A deluxe continental breakfast is included at your leisure each morning.**

Two Ogunquit Trolley tokens per person are included in the tour package for your use exploring Ogunquit today. The trolley stop is beside the hotel and offers a convenient transfer to Perkins Cove, Ogunquit village or Ogunquit Beach. There are shops, galleries and antiques stores to browse in the village, a beautiful beach to stroll and the cove features a pretty drawbridge, charming shops, bobbing lobster boats. The Marginal Way has benches to sit and watch the crashing surf and spans the 1 ¼ mile between the cove, village and beach.

This afternoon, set sail on a large tour boat from Perkins Cove for the Nubble Lighthouse Cruise (2-3:30). This 90-minute trip follows Maine's southernmost coastline from Ogunquit to York Harbor. Don't forget your camera as breathtaking photo ops as you circle the seldom seen back of the lighthouse.

Dinner on your own or you may choose to have your included dinner at Jonathan's tonight.

8:00-10:15 pm

This evening you'll attend the musical "**Cabaret**" at the historic **Ogunquit Playhouse**, located two blocks from the hotel. Transportation not included, free parking on-site. Great seats!



Decadent nightlife meets dangerous times at Berlin's alluring Kit Kat Klub in the iconic Broadway musical. Set in the cabaret underworld on the eve of Hitler's rise to power, this unforgettable musical tells the story of Cliff Bradshaw, a young American writer newly arrived in Berlin, who falls in love with cabaret singer Sally Bowles. Their romance sizzles amid the back room culture of the cabaret and the tumultuous atmosphere of pre-Nazi Germany.

### **Friday, July 19**

After your included breakfast at leisure, check out of the hotel by 11am.

Ogunquit was one of America's first art colonies. Included is admission on Thursday or Friday to the **Ogunquit Museum of American Art**, which has described as "the most beautiful small art museum in the world". The museum features 20th century American Art and is located in a spectacular waterfront setting near Perkins Cove (free parking on site, go **at your leisure 10:00-5:00 Thursday or Friday**). It is a 10 minute walk from the art museum to Perkins Cove over the pretty draw bridge.
